Le materie per le quali si chiede supporto (a livello base per tutte le tre discipline) sono: lingua italiana, lingua inglese ed informatica.


I docenti volontari che aderiranno saranno supportati in tutto il necessario da parte dell'Organizzazione del progetto:

Project: “Building your Future in Ukraine”

English language and computer skills

Place of action	The Ukrainian orphanages of Udaizi (Pryluky) and Pryluky
Objectives of the action	Contribute to reduce the social disadvantages of the young living in Ukrainian orphanages; improve English and computer skills; strengthen self-esteem in those young people; support and recognize their inner potential; cooperate with local schools, governmental and non-governmental partners to reduce marginalized youth unemployment; develop relations between Italian young and adult people and Ukrainian disadvantaged youth
Target group	Students from 10 to 18
Estimated results	Disadvantaged girls and boys have enlarged school skills; the young are more self-confident; young women and men get support to implement their career plan; they learn to work hard using all their potential in order to obtain results; effective cooperation between Italian and Ukrainian teachers, associations and schools is increased; orphan youth’s knowledge of the “real” world is improved; recreative and training experiences with Italian teachers are increased; friendship ties are augmented;
Main activities	Training sessions: a variety of experienced Italian teachers go periodically to the orphanages to teach the young the English language and informatics

Description of the activities

TRAINING SESSIONS

One English language teacher and one informatics teacher go each month from January to May for a period of ten days to the orphanages of Udaizi and Pryluky to give extra opportunities to the traditional orphanage teaching.

At the end of the lessons in May, after a test, a certification is given to each student.

Periods suggested

January: from the 14th to the 24th

February: from the 11th to the 21st

March: from the 4th to the 14th

April: from the 15th to the 25th

May: from the 13th to the 23rd
